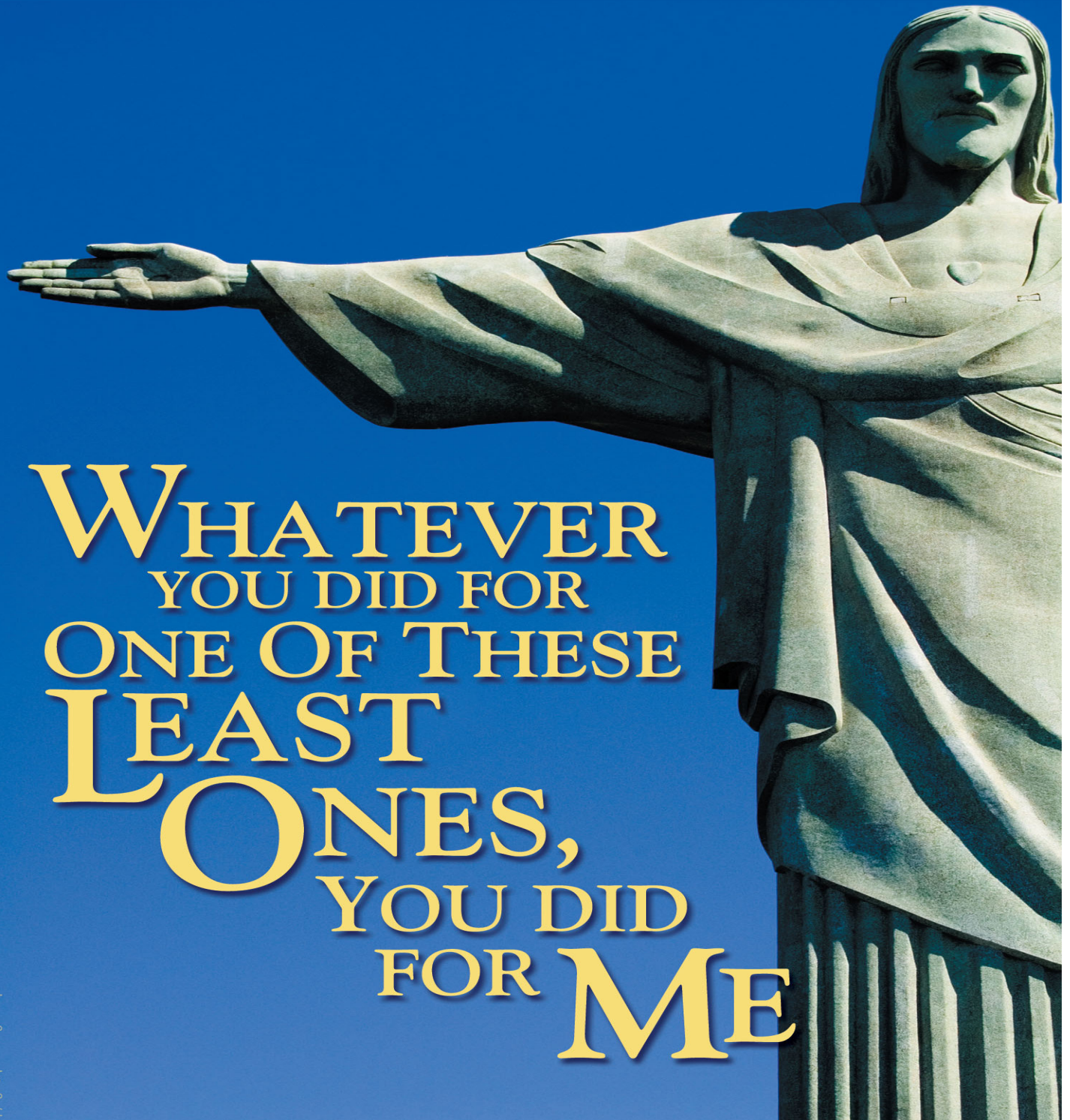

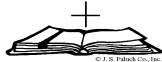

ADVENT BIBLE STUDY

- * A recipe for preparing locusts and wild honey recently uncovered in the Dead Sea region.
- * Two Greek words from the message of John the Baptist "Te hodo" (the way) that occur ubiquitously in the Bible and have deep significance for the beginnings of our church.
- * The gradual development in the old testament of the notion of "the word becoming flesh", as it relates to the incarnation of Jesus.

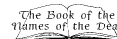
We enable our parish to:
