



St. John Vianney Adoration Chapel Giving Chart

As you may be aware, one of the four areas of focus for the Parish Council was to establish Perpetual Adoration in our parish. As we have prayerfully gone about this journey, under the leadership of our Fr. Ray, the Parish Council has taken on the project of creating a 24-hour Adoration Chapel within the walls of St. John Vianney Church.

Using existing space, repurposed materials and artifacts from the deconstruction of the Mt. St. Rita Chapel along with updating of mechanical, electric and security systems, the Council has worked to put a plan in place to make the Adoration Chapel a reality. In order to raise the necessary funds to build a safe, accessible, appropriate holy place to formally adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, "giving levels" have been created. We are asking that parishioners prayerfully determine if they are in a financial position to participate in this important endeavor, which we know will help to build our relationship with God and each other, and become an integral part of our Catholic faith life. The giving level opportunities are associated with items that have either been donated, repurposed or are part of the overall plan for the Chapel, and are as follows:

Stained Glass Window – “The Visitation” - 2 opportunities	\$ 7,500 each
Stained Glass Window – “The Prodigal Son” (<i>Committed</i>)	\$ 7,500
Stained Glass Window – “Divine Mercy” (<i>Committed</i>)	\$ 7,500
Pedestal for the Blessed Sacrament – 1 opportunity (<i>Committed</i>)	\$ 7,500
Prayer Wall – 1 remaining opportunities (2 - <i>Committed</i>)	\$ 5,000 each
Security System – 2 opportunities	\$ 2,000 each
Chapel Lighting – 2 opportunities (2 - <i>Committed</i>)	\$ 1,500 each
Bronze Kneelers – 2 opportunity (2 - <i>Committed</i>)	\$ 1,500 each
Chairs – 6 remaining opportunities (12 - <i>Committed</i>)	\$ 1,000 each
Pathway to Prayer (3-5/8” x 8” engraved bricks) – 104 opportunities (46 - <i>Committed</i>)	\$ 120 each
